Passport Puerto Rico is a bilingual Spanish/English camp welcoming nearly 100 participants this summer from the States, Puerto Rico, and—for the first time—the Dominican Republic! Moving seamlessly between Spanish and English, our gifted bilingual staff primarily from Puerto Rico created spaces where every camper could engage fully—in worship, Bible study, mission projects, and more.

Collectively, these family resources have been **downloaded 3,565 times** this year, representing thousands of faith conversations shared between parents and their children across the country.
